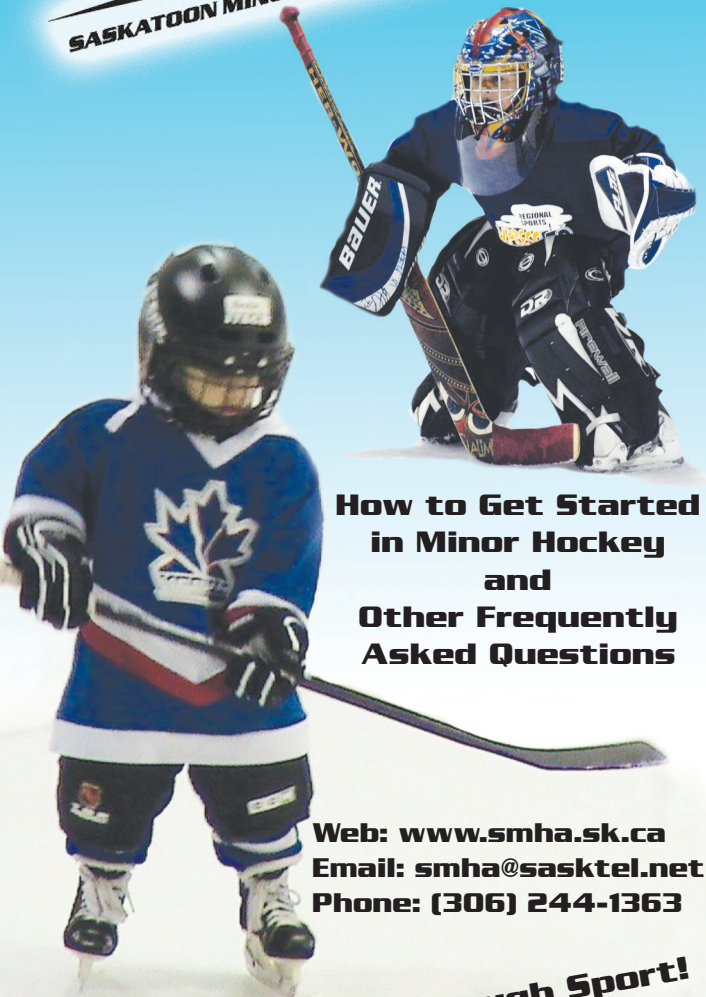

What age groups does the SMHA offer programs for?

The SMHA offers programs for boys and girls ages 5 through 18.

What is a SMHA “Zone”?

The SMHA divides the City of Saskatoon into six geographic zones and one city-wide female hockey zone (**Comets**). Depending on where you live, you will play in one of the following zones: **Aces** (southwest), **Renegades** (northwest), **Bobcats** (south central), **Flyers** (southeast), **Redwings** (northeast) or the **Wild** (northeast). To find out what zone you are part of please contact the SMHA or check it on our website at www.smha.sk.ca.

How much does it cost to register for minor hockey?

The registration fee to your zone can range from \$325 to \$700 depending on the age group of the player in question.

When does registration for hockey take place?

Each zone conducts its registration evenings in early September. For exact dates and locations of your zone registration, please see the SMHA website or watch for your Fall Leisure Guide in August for more information.

Can I register past the regular registration date?

Yes, please contact the SMHA office for information but you are welcome!

Does my child have to play contact hockey (i.e. with body checking)?

No, the SMHA offers excellent Recreational and Non-Contact programs. A player may play non-contact hockey from age 5 through age 18 if they wish to.
